



In this study, we will discover that thing we've always wanted; that world we've longed for; that life we were meant to live; that goal we were meant to pursue—in a word, heaven.



Have you come to **know** Jesus? If so, is the **story** of how you came to grasp the value of God's kingdom more like Matthew 13:44, or more like Matthew 13:45-46?

What would it look like to live a life that reflects a **value** for God's kingdom **above all else?**

What is a **proper response** to Jesus' parable of the net? (Matthew 13:47-50)

Reflect on Jesus' disciple **Peter's sermon** in Acts 2, especially verses 22-36.

- * How did Peter practically live out Jesus' parable of the **master of a house**? (Matthew 13:52)
- * What steps can we likewise take to be trained as "scribes of the kingdom of heaven"? (consider Acts 4:13)

What is Jesus' **intended meaning** behind these other parables from Matthew 13?
