





Vision for Biblical Community
A church that Prays together (v.13-18)
-A church that Praises together (v.13)
-A church that Petitions on another's behalf (v.16) - "Gospel Transparency"
A church that Pursues one another (v.19-20)
A church that Positions itself under God's Word

Further Reflection:

1) How's your prayer life? Or perhaps a better question, how is your communion with God? What hindrances do you experience?
2) We simply cannot pray for one another if we aren't open with others about our struggles and needs (Gospel Transparency). Do you have someone that you feel comfortable sharing difficult things with, even confessing sin to? Let this text today encourage you in being free to open up with others in this body. What does your next step look like?
3) We are called to pursue the wanderer, especially those connected to the local body here at FCC. How can you better position yourself in proximity to those within this body. We would rather start a pursuit a few steps behind, not miles.
4) James calls the Church to faith and obedience in many areas of life. A few commentators succinctly summarize the letter of James like this, "The sovereign God

(2:19), who is able to save and to destroy (4:12), sends forth the 'word of truth' (1:18), which saves those who humbly receive it (1:21), and increasing purity leads to the maturity God desires at the coming triumph of God's reign." In what areas of life has

James challenged you to live differently, in light of the gospel of Jesus Christ?
