INTRODUCTION

God has given us the core values that are important for His people to live by and thereby become a great people who add value to others and improve their quality of life.

NUMBER 1. Jesus came to give life.

JOHN 10:10,27-28

The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly....My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me. ²⁸ And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand.

A. Quality of Life - Zoe, Divine or spiritual life.

2 PETER 1:4

by which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption *that is* in the world through lust.

B. Abundance of Fruit

GALATIANS 5:22-23

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law.

2 CORINTHIANS 3:2

You are our epistle written in our hearts, known and read by all men;

TITUS 2:11-14

For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men, ¹² teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age, ¹³ looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ, ¹⁴ who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself *His* own special people, zealous for good works.

• Acts of kindness I do for others

ACTS 9:36-40

At Joppa there was a certain disciple named Tabitha, which is translated Dorcas. This woman was full of good works and charitable deeds which she did. ³⁷ But it happened in those days that she became sick and died. When they had washed her, they laid *her* in an upper room. ³⁸ And since Lydda was near Joppa, and the disciples had heard that Peter was there, they sent two men to him, imploring *him* not to delay in coming to them. ³⁹ Then Peter arose and went with them. When he had come, they brought *him* to the upper room. And all the widows stood by him weeping, showing the tunics and garments which Dorcas had made while she was with them. ⁴⁰ But Peter put them all out, and knelt down and prayed. And turning to the body he said, "Tabitha, arise." And she opened her eyes, and when she saw Peter she sat up

• It is expected of spiritually mature believers. (Babies don't teach but just eat, create work for others, need cleaned up and supervised.)

HEBREWS 5:12-14

For though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need *someone* to teach you again the first principles of the oracles of God; and you have come to need milk and not solid food. ¹³ For everyone who partakes *only* of milk *is* unskilled in the word of righteousness, for he is a babe. ¹⁴ But solid food belongs to those who are of full age, *that is*, those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.

Paul expected his disciples to disciple other, teach them the way.

2 TIMOTHY 2:1-2

You therefore, my son, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus. ² And the things that you have heard from me among many witnesses, commit these to faithful men who will be able to teach others also.

- Three dimensional biblical relationships, Paul-Barnabas-Timothy (Rebecca's coaching)

C. Fellowship - TALK TO OTHERS

• "One Another's" suggest a relationship of community.

JOHN 13:34-35

A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another. ³⁵ By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another."

• Christians are family members.

JOHN 20:17

Jesus said to her, "Do not cling to Me, for I have not yet ascended to My Father; but go to My brethren and say to them, 'I am ascending to My Father and your Father, and to My God and your God."

• Love of the brethren is normal for family.

1 JOHN 3:14

We know that we have passed from death to life, because we love the brethren. He who does not love *his* brother abides in death.
