

## LAST DAYS MONEY

**JAMES 5:1-3** Come now, *you* rich, weep and howl for your miseries that are coming upon *you!* **2** Your riches [a]are corrupted, and your garments are moth-eaten. **3** Your gold and silver are corroded, and their corrosion will be a witness against you and will eat your flesh like fire. You have heaped up treasure in the last days.

### NUMBER 1. God want to keep His Word.

A. Do you understand the Covenant.

**DEUTERONOMY 8:18** "And you shall remember the Lord your God, for *it is* He who gives you power to get wealth, that He may establish His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as *it is* this day.

**DEUTERONOMY 28:11-13** And the Lord will grant you plenty of goods, in the fruit of your body, in the increase of your livestock, and in the produce of your ground, in the land of which the Lord swore to your fathers to give you. **12** The Lord will open to you His good treasure, the heavens, to give the rain to your land in its season, and to bless all the work of your hand. You shall lend to many nations, but you shall not borrow. **13** And the Lord will make you the head and not the tail; you shall be above only, and not be beneath, if you heed the commandments of the Lord your God, which I command you today, and are careful to observe *them*.

### NUMBER 2. God wants to get money into the hands of the right people.

**PROVERBS 13:22** A good *man* leaves an inheritance to his children's children, But the wealth of the sinner is stored up for the righteous.

**PSALMS 105:37** He also brought them out with silver and gold, And *there was* none feeble among His tribes.

**2 CHRONICLES 20:25** When Jehoshaphat and his people came to take away their spoil, they found among them an abundance of valuables on the dead bodies, and precious jewelry, which they stripped off for themselves, more than they could carry away; and they were three days gathering the spoil because there was so much.

### NUMBER 3. People who know the purpose of money.

**1 TIMOTHY 6:17** Command those who are rich in this present age not to be haughty, nor to trust in uncertain riches but in the living God, who gives us richly all things to enjoy.

A. ENJOY IT. Make all you can, save all you can, give all you can.

B. DISTRIBUTE IT.

**ACTS 4:31-35** And when they had prayed, the place where they were assembled together was shaken; and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and they spoke the word of God with boldness. **32** Now the multitude of those who believed were of one heart and one soul; neither did anyone say that any of the things he possessed was his own, but they had all things in common. **33** And with great power the apostles gave witness to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. And great grace was upon them all. **34** Nor was there anyone among them who lacked; for all who were possessors of lands or houses sold them, and brought the proceeds of the things that were sold, **35** and laid *them* at the apostles' feet; and they distributed to each as anyone had need.

C. COMMUNICATE IT

**PHILIPPIANS 4:10-20** But I rejoiced in the Lord greatly that now at last your[a] care for me has flourished again; though you surely did care, but you lacked opportunity. **11** Not that I speak in regard to need, for I have learned in whatever state I am, to be content: **12** I know how to [b]be abased, and I know how to [c]abound. Everywhere and in all things I have learned both to be full and to be hungry, both to abound and to suffer need. **13** I can do all things through [d]Christ who strengthens me. **14** Nevertheless you have done well that you shared in my distress. **15** Now you Philippians know also that in the beginning of the gospel, when I departed from Macedonia, no church shared with me concerning giving and receiving but you only. **16** For even in Thessalonica you sent *aid* once and again for my necessities. **17** Not that I seek the gift, but I seek the fruit that abounds to your account. **18** Indeed I [e]have all and abound. I am full, having received from Epaphroditus the things *sent* from you, a sweet-smelling aroma, an acceptable sacrifice, well pleasing to God. **19** And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus. **20** Now to our God and Father *be* glory forever and ever. Amen.

D. *Finance a great harvest of salvations.*

## NUMBER 4. People that have been proven faithful.

**PROVERBS 16:10-12** Divination *is* on the lips of the king; His mouth must not transgress in judgment. 11 Honest weights and scales *are* the Lord's; All the weights in the bag *are* His work. 12 *It is* an abomination for kings to commit wickedness, For a throne is established by righteousness.

**PROVERBS 28:20,22** A faithful man will abound with blessings, But he who hastens to be rich will not go unpunished... **22** A man with an evil eye hastens after riches, And does not consider that poverty will come upon him.

## NUMBER 5. People who have spiritual qualities. Calling and Construction of Joseph.

### A. CONSISTENCY

**PSALMS 105:19** Until the time that his word came to pass, The word of the Lord tested him.

### B. CHASTITY

**GENESIS 39:7-9** And it came to pass after these things that his master's wife [a]cast longing eyes on Joseph, and she said, "Lie with me." **8** But he refused and said to his master's wife, "Look, my master does not know what *is* with me in the house, and he has committed all that he has to my hand. **9** *There is* no one greater in this house than I, nor has he kept back anything from me but you, because you *are* his wife. How then can I do this great wickedness, and sin against God?"

### C. CREDIBILITY

**GENESIS 39:5-6** So it was, from the time *that* he had made him overseer of his house and all that he had, that the Lord blessed the Egyptian's house for Joseph's sake; and the blessing of the Lord was on all that he had in the house and in the field. **6** Thus he left all that he had in Joseph's [a]hand, and he did not know what he had except for the bread which he ate. Now Joseph was handsome in form and appearance.

### D. CLARITY

**GENESIS 45:5-8** But now, do not therefore be grieved or angry with yourselves because you sold me here; for God sent me before you to

preserve life. **6** For these two years the famine *has been* in the land, and *there are* still five years in which *there will be* neither plowing nor harvesting. **7** And God sent me before you to preserve a [a]posteriority for you in the earth, and to save your lives by a great deliverance. **8** So now *it was* not you *who* sent me here, but God; and He has made me a father to Pharaoh, and lord of all his house, and a ruler throughout all the land of Egypt.

## NUMBER 6. End Time Josephs.

**ACTS 7:9-11** "And the patriarchs, becoming envious, sold Joseph into Egypt. But God was with him **10** and delivered him out of all his troubles, and gave him favor and wisdom in the presence of Pharaoh, king of Egypt; and he made him governor over Egypt and all his house. **11** Now a famine and great trouble came over all the land of Egypt and Canaan, and our fathers found no sustenance.
