Worship begins with an inward attitude and is expressed by our outward actions.

So what is WORSHIP? **WIKIPEDIA.COM says** The word is derived from the <u>Old English</u> weorbscipe, meaning worship, honour shown to an object,^[1] which has been etymologised as "worthiness or worth-ship"—to give, at its simplest, worth to something.^[2]

NUMBER 1. Worship is what we were created to do.

READ ACTS 17:24-27 The word SEEK in this verse is from the GREEK word: Zeteo with means to WORSHIP.

NUMBER 2. Worship begins in our hearts and is expressed through our bodies.

- A. **Vocal Expressions:** Shouting, singing, praying, talking, proclaiming, and declaring. Your voice is the speaker of your heart.
- B. **Physical Expressions:** Standing, bowing, kneeling, dancing, lifting hands, applauding His greatness. **READ LAMENTATIONS 3:41 & PSALM 47:1**
- C. **Silent Expressions:** This expression can be through tears, bowing or kneeling and meditating on His greatness. **READ PSALM 46:10**
- D. **Musical Expressions:** We can devote a talent we have to God. Like David did in the Old Testament. **READ PSALMS 33:2-3**

NUMBER 3. We worship God because He alone is WORTHY.
