### **PASTOR'S TEACHING CORNER**

Have Faith In God-Mark 11:20-26

20 And in the morning, as they passed by, they saw the fig tree dried up from the roots. 21 And 22 And 23 For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. 24 Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them. 25 And 26 But if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses.

Rev. Lane shared the following.

- 1. Faith is hope and trust that does not ask for proof.
- 2. God created the ending before the beginning.
- 3. Three things that can hinder your prayer life:
  - a. Your level of faith
  - b. Alignment with the will of God
  - c. Unforgiveness in your heart

- 1. Make sure you are walking with God.
- 2. Check your heart.
- 3. Start the conversation with prayer.
- 4. Recognize that not challenging ungodly actions can open the door for the Enemy.
- 5. Do vour homework.
- 6. Consider possible reactions, responses and goals ahead of
- 7. Clarify and state your goal: to redeem even if you must rebuke.
- 8. Ask guestions more than make statements.
- 9. Work toward a stated solution.
- 10. Keep praying silently during the conversation.
- 11. Assume you will pray together after the conversation.
