
### PASTOR'S TEACHING CORNER

Sunday's Sermon: The Power of Prayer - Mark Chater 6, Verse 45-46.

<sup>45</sup>And straightway he constrained his disciples to get into the ship, and to go to the other side before unto Bethsaida, while he sent away the people.<sup>46</sup>And when he had sent them away, he departed into a mountain to pray.

Reverend Messenger shared a lesson about the powers of prayer. She stated that prayer was important to Jesus, and it should be important to each of us. She also said that when Jesus prayed, He received from His Father whatever He needed to carry out His mission on earth. The following points were left for us:
