PASTOR'S TEACHING CORNER

I Feel a Breakthrough - Mark Chapter 5 verses 25-29

25 And a certain woman, which had an issue of blood twelve years, 26 and had suffered many things of many physicians, and had spent all that she had, and was nothing bettered, but rather grew worse, 27 when she had heard of Jesus, came in the press behind, and touched his garment. 28 For she said, If I may touch but his clothes, I shall be whole. 29 And straightway the fountain of her blood was dried up; and she felt in her body that she was healed of that plague.

Pastor Hightower shared three miracles from Chapter 5 with us. The first miracle was when He encountered a man with an unclean spirit. The text said the man had his dwelling among the tombs. He lived in the graveyard. The text said, no man could bind him because chains and fetters could not hold him. It said at night and day, he was in the mountains, and in the tombs, crying, and cutting himself with stones. But when he saw Jesus afar off, he ran and worshipped him, and cried with a loud voice, Jesus, thou Son of the most high God. He received his breakthrough.

Then there was Jairus' daughter. The text said when Jesus got to the other side, He met a man by the name of Jairus. Jarius was one of the rulers of the synagogue. Jarius told Jesus, " My daughter lieth at the point of death: I pray thee, come and lay thy hands on her, that she may be healed; and she shall live. As they were talking, one of Jairus' men showed up and said, " Thy daughter is dead: why troubles thou the Master any further? Jesus went to Jarius' house, touched the daughter, and she received her breakthrough.

The third breakthrough in Chapter 5 is this woman who had an issue of blood. This woman shows up in the text out of nowhere. The text said she had an issue of blood that she had been struggling with for 12 years. She hooked up with Jesus, and her issue was resolved. She received her breakthrough.

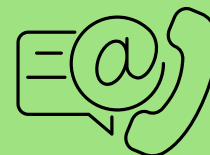
