Let's get some facts out of the way

- Who wrote this book---Paul.
- Who did he write it to—The Church in Rome.
- When was Romans written--- it was written from Corinth on Paul's third missionary journey---probably 60 A.D.

Two words about the Roman church

- It had been around for awhile--Paul writes that he had desired to visit them "these many years" (15:23).
- The church was strong enough to help him carry out further missionary activities.
- They are not called "recent converts".
- They are an organized and well-grounded congregation (15:14, "filled with all knowledge, able also to admonish one another").

Where does The Book of Romans stack up in Paul letters.

-First and Second Thessalonians- Philippians

-Galatians -Philemon

-First and Second Corinthians - First Timothy

-Romans-- Titus

Colossians Second Timothy.

-Ephesians

-Romans is his longest letter.

THE BOOK OF ROMANS-INTRODUCTION The Theme of the Book of Romans

- The theme--Gospel of Christ (Rom. 1:16,17).
- -Romans explains how a sinner can be received as righteous by a righteous God.
- -How a justified sinner should live daily to the glory of God.

Justification (1:18—5:11)

Sanctification (5:12—8:39)

Section on Israel (9:1—11:36)

Practical application (12:1—15:13)

Conclusion (15:14—16:27)

Introduced To Some New Concepts

Justification: To declare righteous.

Justification is an act of God whereby He pronounces a sinner to be righteous because of that sinner's faith in Christ.

THE BOOK OF ROMANS-INTRODUCTION Introduced To Some New Concepts

 Condemnation: a statement or expression of very strong and definite criticism or disapproval.

Introduced To Some New Concepts

Manifestation: An outward or perceptible indication; materialization, a public demonstration.

THE BOOK OF ROMANS-INTRODUCTION Introduced To Some New Concepts

 Harmonization (with the Law): to be in lockstep with, to add too and not take away.

- Exultation: Filled with or expressing great joy or triumph.

THE BOOK OF ROMANS-INTRODUCTION How will I know that I understand what is happening in The Book of Romans?

1st. When you sincerely believe that God so love the world that He gave His son to die for our sins.

2nd—That belief causes us to accept the fact that through Jesus' atoning blood, we can be grafted into a relationship with God.

3rd—Through faith, we accept that relationship by confessing with our mouth and believing in our heart that God raised His Son from the grave.

4th—Because we have peace with God through faith and through the atoning blood of Christ, we offer ourselves as living sacrifices, which is considered our reasonable service.
