PASTOR'S TEACHING CORNER

A Miracle of Compassion - Matthew chapter 14, verses 23 and 14.

¹³When Jesus heard of it, he departed thence by ship into a desert place apart: and when the people had heard thereof, they followed him on foot out of the cities. ¹⁴And Jesus went forth, and saw a great multitude, and was moved with compassion toward them, and he healed their sick.

In this text, Jesus received some bad news. The bad news caused Him to seal away to be alone. On his journey, He encountered 5,000 men, not counting women and children. He healed them out of compassion. They were hungry, so He fed them out of that same compassion. Pastor Hightower shared the following points with the congregation:

- 1. Don't discount what you are working with it is enough.
- 2. Your bread and your fish is in the wrong hands.
- 3. Your Bread and fish are closer than you think.
- 4. Jesus is concerned about leftovers.

There were four reasons that Jesus performed miracles:

- 1. Miracles glorified God and showed that Jesus was indeed the Son of God.
- 2. It was a way for Jesus to touch the lives of many people with the manifestation of His power.
- 3. His miracles demonstrated God's great love and compassion for humanity.
- 4. They were used to fulfill messianic prophecies that describe what would happen when God's anointed came.

The class also learned the number of miracles Jesus performed. The exact number of miracles Jesus performed is unknown, but the New Testament records between 35 and 42. The reason there is not an exact number is because not everything that could have been a miracle was recorded. The Gospel of John said that if everything were recorded, the book could not hold it all.
