I am Doing A Great Work, I Can't Come Down, Nehemiah Chapter 6:2-3

2 Sanballat and Geshem sent me this message: "Come, let us meet together in one of the villages[a] on the plain of Ono." But they were scheming to harm me; 3 so I sent messengers to them with this reply: "I am carrying on a great project and cannot go down. Why should the work stop while I leave it and go down to you?"

The preacher made the point that when we are working for God, we can't stop because of the crowd. Three points of reference:

- If God is in it, He will make provisions for it.
- If God is in it, our job is to stay with it.
- We need to take care of God's house first, then God will take care of our house.
