Golden Wishes Gifts & Delivery

Golden Wishes is our way of spreading Christmas joy to the senior citizens in our community. We work with social services to obtain names and gift ideas from seniors they serve, then share their wishes and needs through Sign-up Genius. A sign-up sheet is also available in the church vestibule. All gifts will be collected at church a week before delivery so we can ensure that each person on the list is covered.

On Saturday, December 16th, we will require many volunteers to deliver the gifts and a meal to every recipient. The meal is provided and cooked at the church and picked up along with the gifts. We also reach out to elderly or sick church members who may enjoy a visit or meal and include them on the day of delivery. However, we do not provide gifts for our church seniors.

You can choose to buy a gift, deliver gifts, or do both to help with this ministry. Many people enjoy visiting the person they purchase a gift for. Presently, 56 individuals may require a visit on December 16th, and we will need many volunteers for this day. We will meet at the church at 11AM to pick up gifts, meals, and contact information.
