

JOURNEY TO THE CROSS

Station #2 “Sin: The Fall of Man”

You should now be in the prayer chapel. Find a place to sit as you reflect on the next stage of our journey.

The perfect world God created didn't stay perfect for very long. Genesis 3 tells us that though the first people had everything they needed, they chose not to trust God's good design. They thought they knew better. This led to shame, guilt, and death.

Consider some of the ways you have personally experienced brokenness through sin. No matter what you or anyone might try, we cannot escape our condition.

There is good news. God made a way to overcome sin. But we can't appreciate the good news until we contend with the bad news of our guilt.

If you like, watch the video (titled “The Fall Poem”) that creatively retells the way sin and brokenness entered the world, or read the passage from Genesis 2:15-17, Gen. 3:1-24 from the printed pages near you.

When you are ready, take a stone from the basket, representing the burden of sin, and move into the sanctuary, where you'll find a window marked Station 3.
