12 Actions of Humility

(Adapted from St. Benedict’s
“The Twelve Steps to Humility”) ~500 AD

- Intentionally seek humility as an act of obedience.
- Seek God’s will above my own will. (John 6:38)
- Confess your sins to God quickly. (1 John 1:9)
- Persevere through sickness and affliction quietly. (Romans 8:37)
- Study God’s word and live it out daily.
- Practice praising and complimenting others.
- Use my gifts and talents to serve others.
- Plan regular times of fasting.
- Be a friend to others who are going through humbling times.
- Restrict my sarcasm.
- Speak gently and practice silence.
- Be modest in my appearance and actions.
