Revival

“CHAYAH”

strongs H2421

Revival is NOT a simply emotional experience. It is not an exciting church service or even large crowds. Can God bring revival while doing these things? Yes.
But it is not these outward signs alone.

Biblical revival at its core is God restoring spiritual LIFE among HIS people.

PSALM 85:6 “WILT THOU NOT **REVIVE US AGAIN: THAT THY PEOPLE MAY REJOICE IN THEE?”**

That word “revive” there is the Hebrew word “Chayah”
(strongs H2421)

the idea being “cause us to live again”

We see something that possesses life that has now become weak, faint, dormant or diminished and God then can cause life to flourish in it again.

the true biblical roots of revival are speaking to THE
CHURCH.

Awaken the
sleeper cells

In Habakkuk 3:2 he is crying out to the lord in the middle of a mess and he says

“O LORD, I HAVE HEARD THY SPEECH AND WAS AFRAID: O LORD, REVIVE THY WORK IN THE MIDST OF THE YEARS..”

Habakkuk is praying : YHWH, cause your work to live.

At this point in biblical history, as I mentioned, it was a mess. Judah was spiritually compromised - aka corruption in the house of God. Judgement was approaching and Babylon was on the rise. Aka the emerging world system.

Habakkuk seems to be looking through the telescope of time into 2026.

The people of God need revived, so that the work of the Lord can continue.

Here is another key to revival .. Habakkuk remembers!

“...I have heard thy speech..”

Habakkuk has a memory.

Habakkuk is saying — God, cause your work to live again in our generation!

**“RETURN TO ME AND I WILL RETURN TO YOU, SAYS
THE LORD OF HOSTS” -MALACHI 3:7**

Think about Hosea, God speaking through the prophets of old and even the
Song of Solomon which poetically shows us a Kong longing to be loved for who
he is, not what he can offer.*

Revival is God calling us to become alive again.

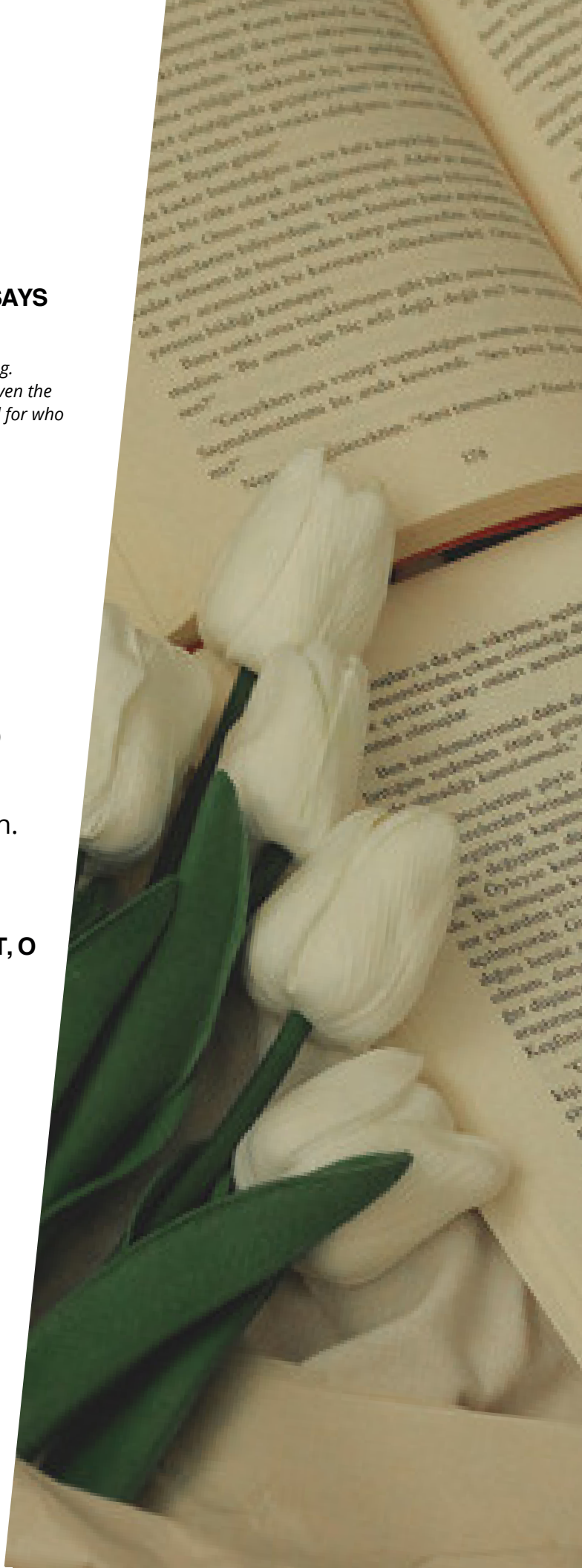
To return to him in covenant.

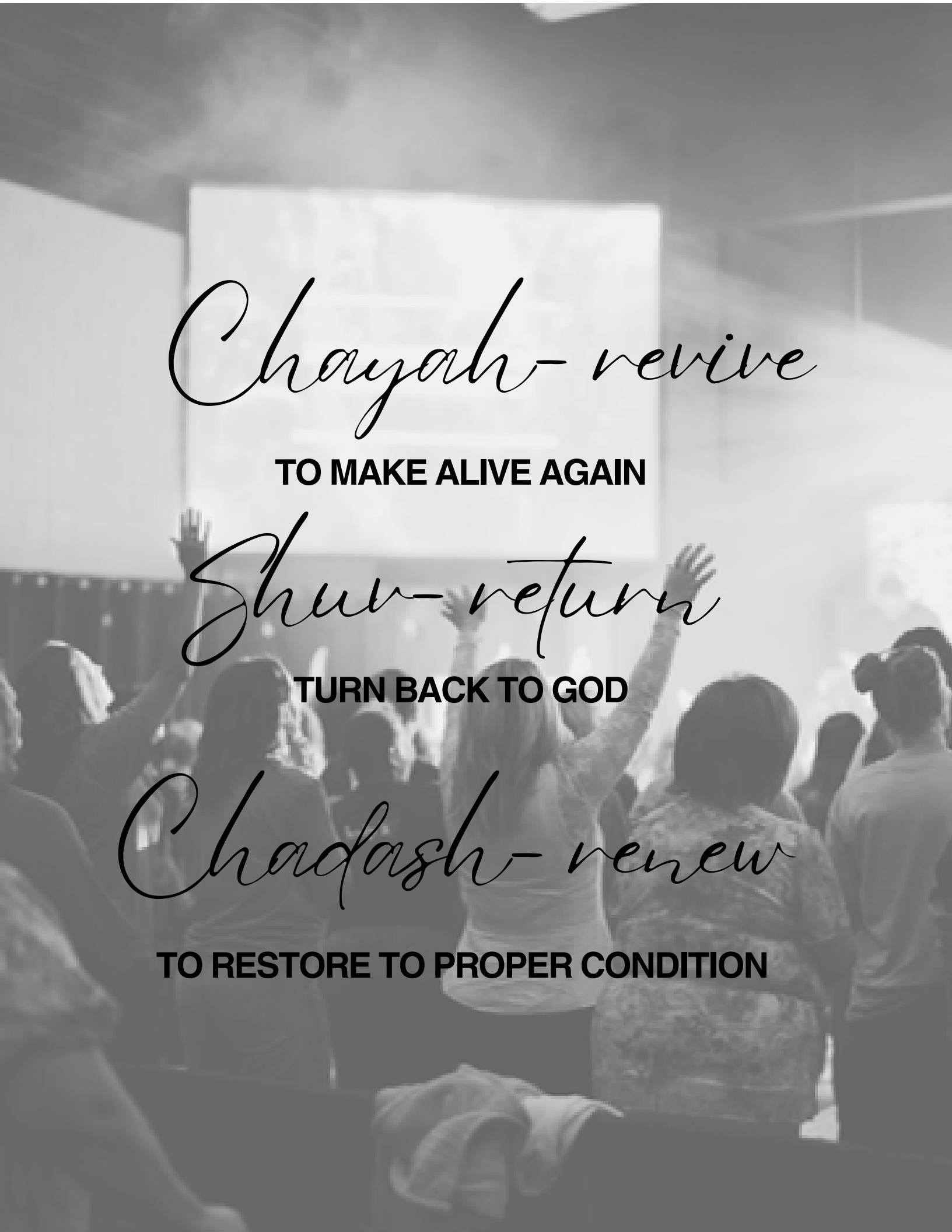
And to renew through repentance.

**PSALM 51:10 SAYS “CREATE IN ME A CLEAN HEART, O
GOD; AND RENEW A RIGHT SPIRIT WITHIN ME”**

This chapter of Psalms was written by King David who was found in the middle of sin. He recognizes this sin and cries out to God for cleansing (a pure heart) and then renewal.

Renewal gets to the root of the sin.
We don't simply ask God to forgive us when we are in pursuit of revival. **We are asking for him to forgive and renew. To expose the root of the sin, to pull it up and out, and to replace it with His spirit.**





Chayah- revive

Shuv- return

TURN BACK TO GOD

Chadash- renew

TO RESTORE TO PROPER CONDITION

To live again, to revive

“ANAZAO” Strong's G326

“FOR THIS MY SON WAS DEAD, AND IS ALIVE AGAIN; HE WAS LOST, AND IS FOUND” -LUKE 15:24

See. The prodigal was already a son, he just forgot that true freedom was found in the father's house, at the table.

This prodigal son parable is a picture of revival among sons and daughters, and it mirrors the Old Testament cry for revival.

EPHESIANS 5:14

“AWAKE THOU THAT SLEEPERS, AND ARISE FROM THE DEAD, AND CHRIST SHALL GIVE THEE LIGHT”

It is possible to be physically awake yet spiritually asleep.

Jesus to the church

**“WAKE UP, AND STRENGTHEN WHAT REMAINS AND IS ABOUT TO DIE...”
REV. 3**

Something remains.
But unless there is revival- it will die.

The instruction for this church is simple :
GO BACK to what you heard and believed at first (Habakkuk anyone? He had a memory..)
Hold to it firmly.

Repent (remember psalm 51?)
And turn to me again (shuv return)

THE SOLUTION FOR IT ALL IS REVIVAL

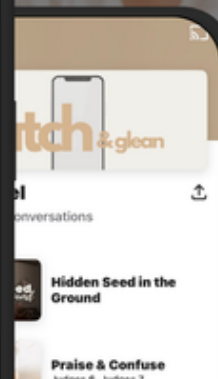
