The Nicene Creed with Scriptures

Today is the Sixth Sunday of Easter

Easter is the celebration of Christ's resurrection from the dead and is the oldest and most sacred of all Christian festivals. After walking with Christ toward the cross during the forty days of Lent, on Easter we give thanks for the life, death, and resurrection of our Savior, and for the truth that "because He lives, we shall live also."

Also known as "The Day of Resurrection," Easter begins a celebration that lasts "fifty great days" from Easter to Pentecost. The season of Easter is marked by the colors white and gold, representing majesty, joy and celebration, and reminding us of Jesus' victory over death on the cross and his glorious Resurrection.
