Proverbs talks of a father handing down wisdom to his son. He teaches him to avoid folly, walk in truth, turn and run from evil, and live a godly life in every season.

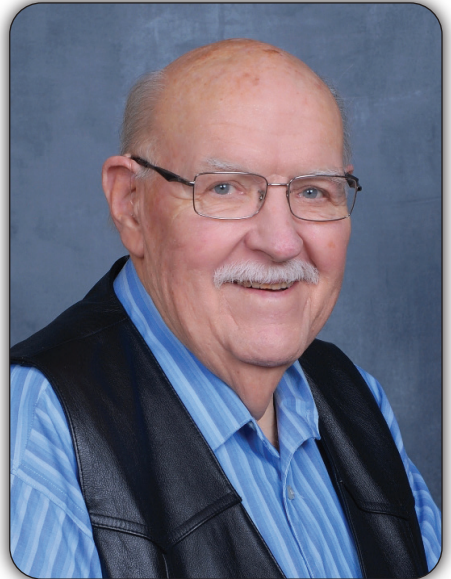

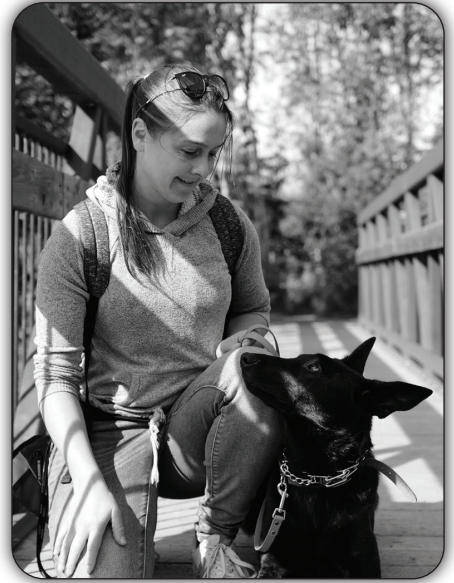
