

## **Daniel 9 – Main Points and Discussion Questions**

### **Three Main Points**

- Scripture shapes prayer: Daniel allows God's Word to direct his understanding and response in prayer.
- God's glory is central: Daniel's prayer focuses on God's character, sovereignty, and faithfulness rather than human merit.
- Grace over performance: God's redemptive work is rooted in His grace, not the people's obedience or righteousness.

2. What does Daniel's immediate response to Scripture reveal about the relationship between God's Word and prayer?

5. How does Daniel 9 challenge the belief that God's favor is earned through good behavior?
6. How can we relate to exiled Israel when it comes to sin and repentance?
7. How does recognizing God's grace change the way we approach confession?
8. What can we learn from Daniel's humility in prayer when reflecting on our own spiritual lives?
9. How does Daniel 9 give hope to those burdened by past sin?
10. In what practical ways should Daniel 9 shape our confidence when approaching God in prayer today?
