Covid Comes Calling

We were preparing for a busy weekend. We were to have a Day of Prayer with our Christar Balkans team Saturday and then on Sunday we had various plans for Valentine's Day. Monday was to start another normal week of school.

Mr. Rona had a different idea. Peter had had a very minor cough on Friday - the kind of thing you don't even raise an eyebrow about unless you are

in the midst of a pandemic. Saturday morning the cough increased and other minor symptoms starting as well. One of the main laboratories in Tirana is just around the corner from our house so Peter dutifully masked up and headed down for testing.

Meanwhile our plans were all set aside while we waited. And waited. At 10:30pm it was confirmed: Peter is the first of our family to get Covid. We are all in quarantine for 10 days. Fortunately, the ministry of education made an announcement on Friday that due to the extremely cold temperatures expected this week that all schools would be moved online. So, GDQ moved back online for another week, which makes it possible for Peter to teach with no interruption to his classes at all. On a different note, we feel sad for students in this Covid year, as it used to be when you had a snow day you actually had a day off school; now it just means a day at home doing school online!

Peter's symptoms so far are fairly minor, more like an unpleasant cold than anything more serious. Obviously Melodye and Jonny have been exposed, but so far have not shown any signs. Please pray that this will continue to be the case (they both would like to somehow get antibodies without being ill;-)) *Peter & Melodye Bowers*

Daniel 1:2a

Scripture Meditation

This morning we start a study on the book of Daniel looking at it as a Survival Guide for living in our culture. The first study of the book sets the stage for all that follows. God gave a pagan king victory over Judah, gave the captives Daniel and friends compassion in the eyes of their captors, and gave Daniel and friends ability that distinguished them above the other captives as well as the native advisers. God had a work to do in Babylon and used faithful men to show a pagan culture that Yahweh's provision, judgment and compassion were far superior to their pagan gods. Pray this morning that God might show us ways to be faithful and excel for His glory. And pray we might each be a point of light and compassion in a hostile culture for His honor.
