# Missionary Update

Recently, several FBC supported missionaries have indicated that they are suffering financially due to loss of support and/or increased living expenses. The church currently supports approximately twenty missionaries or mission organizations out of its budget on a monthly basis. We are sometimes able to meet additional financial requests from our missionaries, however the number of requests received in the past few months has exceeded what we have experienced in the past.

Given the recent budgetary challenges that the church is facing, the missions team is reluctant to prioritize any one need, missionary or ministry over another. However, we do not want the congregation to be unaware that missions needs exist and that some are quite urgent. If you feel called to support global missions beyond what the church supports through your normal tithes and offerings, we would be glad to share some of these financial requests with you. Please speak with a member of the missions team if you feel led to help address some of these needs.

# Meditation

What if people knew the real you, with all your sins, baggage, scars, and messes? Would they still love and accept you? It's far easier to project an image of a trouble-free life than to let people see the real us. Join us this Sunday as we examine how the Gospel speaks to this issue.
