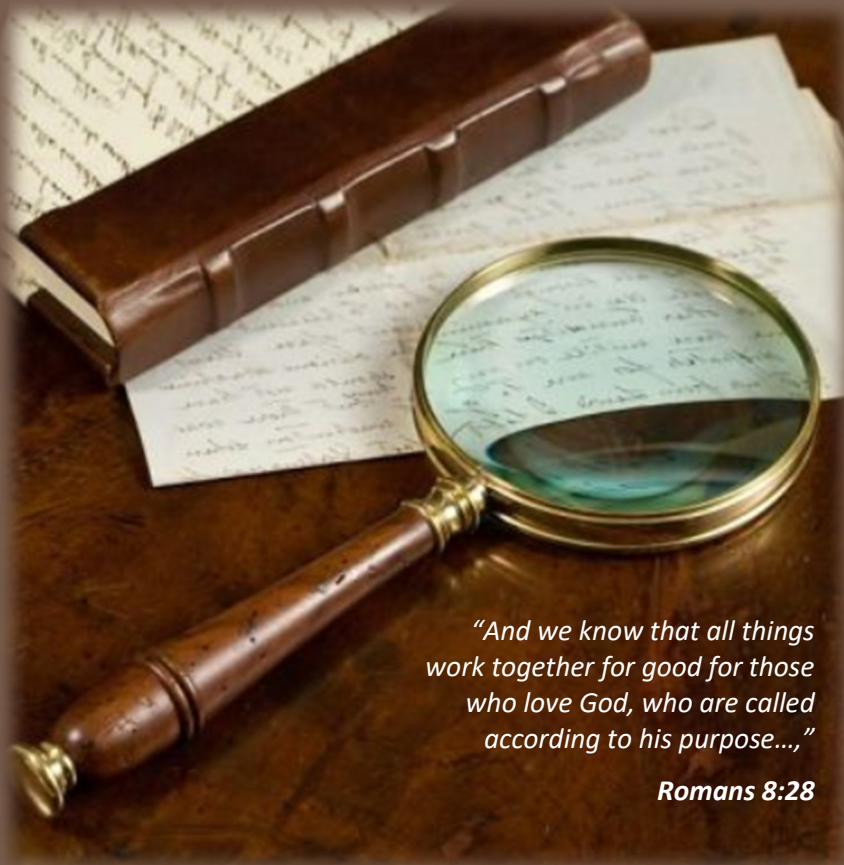

Scripture Meditation

One of the most misused Scripture heard today is in Romans. "All things work together for good" is the way one often hears the passage quoted. The implication that 'everything is going to be fine' is hard to miss. Pray this morning that we understand that this verse is a promise with a limited audience, the children of God through

faith in Christ. And pray that we understand this promise is part of the "not yet" of Christian living. Like the resurrection of our loved ones and the giving of a new heaven and new earth, it is something we look forward to but is still "not yet".
