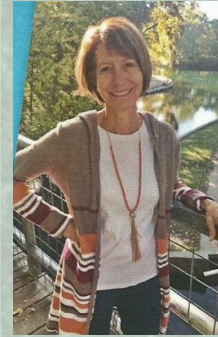

## MINISTRY SPOTLIGHT



Fellowship supported missionary, Jeannie Tabb, serves with Resourcing Christian Education International (RCE) as a recruiter for Kiev Christian Academy in Ukraine. She periodically leads teams to do English clubs in Ukraine, Romania and other countries. She also serves as a coach with Bridges International to reach out and minister to international students.

In her most recent update, she reports about how the past school year went at the different universities where she coaches student leaders with Bridges. At The University of Wisconsin La Crosse, her student leader found new, online ways to meet international students and also worked with the university's international office for the first time. At Eastern Tennessee State, she encouraged her leaders to find ways to successfully share responsibilities for leading Bible study. This group, composed of international students from Africa, was able to meet in person for the first time in May to celebrate their graduates! At Michigan Tech, student volunteers had many opportunities to spend time with Indian friends going to church or Bible study, camping, skiing, and enjoying a homemade Indian meal. Jeannie asks for prayer that God will continue to open doors and hearts to receive His word and get to know Him as Savior.
