Given the recent budgetary challenges that the church is facing, the missions team is reluctant to prioritize any one need, missionary or ministry over another. However, we do not want the congregation to be unaware that missions needs exist and that some are quite urgent. If you feel called to support global missions beyond what the church supports through your normal tithes and offerings, we would be glad to share some of these financial requests with you.
