If you can give two Sundays a month to help our children develop their foundation in Christ, please email Adriane Ledesma at contactus@fellowshipbible.org.

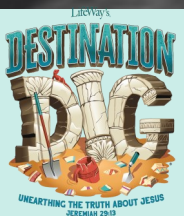
MASK INFORMATION

Hello to all in the Lord's name. My prayer is that you are not being overwhelmed by the events of this last year and last few months—COVID19, economic stress, election problems, unwelcome national directives and the Big Freeze of '21.

As for me, having moved into my ninth decade, there is a normal searching for something to do to further God's kingdom. Being at my brother's place in Texas limits my actual activities in Mexico. I was able to make a short trip to northwest Mexico the end of January. I flew to Phoenix and went down with Mike Hendricks and others in his vehicle. I thank all those who were praying for us because the vehicle we were in developed problems in the transmission. But by Mike's skillful handling of the situation and the grace of God, we arrived safely at our destination.

I was able to see some people I had wanted to see and send some verse cards prepared by a lady from Redemption Church in the Houston area, along with a gallon of rubber cement, something hard to get in Mexico, which was donated by another sister. I traveled to Camp Tayoltita for several days.

I returned to Texas by bus without incident. Thank you for the prayers during February's severe cold blast I am very thankful. My electricity did not go out and I always had water.

Although I did not participate in the Culiacan outreach to the tomato pickers this year, I did send funds to help workers who had a hard time meeting their expenses as participants. Daniel T., was on his way from the Oaxaca area when he was assaulted and robbed of everything he was carrying. But that did not deter him. By the mercy of God and his determination, he still showed up to take part in visiting the camps with the gospel.

Pray with me about another trip to the south in April, if that would be in the plans and the will of God.

STUDENT MINISTRY

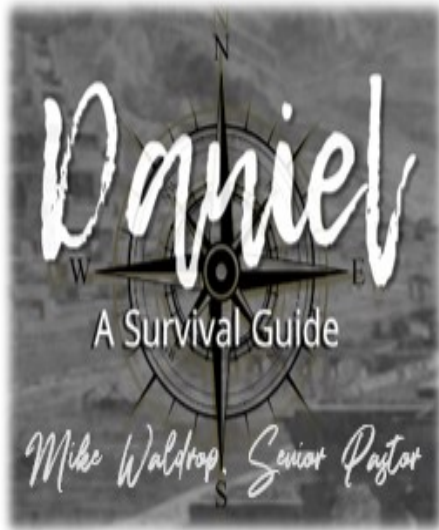

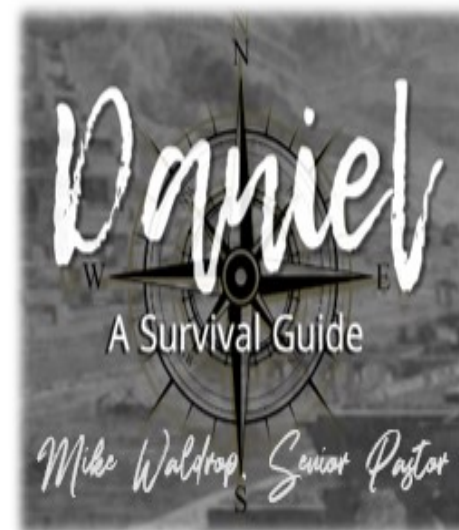
