Turkey Bowl is the time of the year when our students take on the adults of our church in a winner-takes-all, high-stakes, trash-talking, smash-mouthing football game!


This event will feature food, fellowship, football, and games for all ages!

In this role, they train, counsel, and function as pastors for isolated East-West missionaries in hostile and closed countries. In the past year, David has literally traveled around the world, visiting Ukraine, Mongolia, Cambodia, and Indonesia.
