During the month of October, we are partnering with one of our supported ministry organizations, F.A.M.M. (For All Mankind Movement), to provide Compassion Kits to families in need. Compassion Kits serve as a means for reaching people with the compelling message of the gospel. Each kit contains 16

The items for the kits are purchased and the kits are assembled by local workers overseas in the country where the kit will be distributed; kits can also include personal message cards from our church. Scripture Meditation

On the last stop of Jesus' ministry, we see a great power struggle. The Jewish religious authorities, Barabbas the rebel, Pilate the governor, and even the soldiers who crucified Jesus, all wanted something for themselves. And yet Jesus, capable of saving Himself from the horrors of the cross, gave Himself. In giving Himself, His power was demonstrated in supernatural acts of creation, in the temple, and in the lives of people who witnessed His death. Pray this morning that we would be challenged to consider the power we pursue. Have we slipped into pursuing something for ourselves, or are we pursuing the giving of ourselves in pursuit of deeper relationship with the Savior, and ministry to His people?
