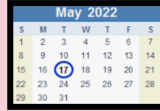
JORDAN TRIP MEETING

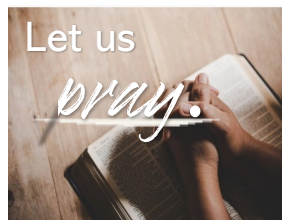

Scripture Meditation

As we consider Peter’s words describing us as exiles and misfits in this world, the implications are that our status in this world must impact our lifestyle. The lifestyle Peter describes for misfits is one that is radically different than the way we normally view our relationships with government, employers and others. Pray this morning that our hearts would be open to hear and consider these implications. Pray that we would be touched by God’s Spirit to allow Him to make us truly radical misfits that bring him honor, and that bring people to Him in love and justice.
