Activity

Faith Verse

What You Need:

No supplies needed

What You Do:

Help your child with the actions to the faith verse. This is the one we have been practicing all month long.

What You Say:

Your verse is about trusting God! Let's say the Faith Verse and do the actions together.

- Trust the LORD (*point up to heaven*)
- with all your heart (*form heart with hands and put hands on chest*)
- and he will show (*One hand above eyebrows*)
- where to go (*march in place*),
- Proverbs (*palms up to form a "book"*)
- 3: (*hands close "book"*)
- 5-6 (*open "book"*)

When you finish the game, say, You've learned that Faith Verse so well!

Talk About the Bible Story

Sometimes we all feel scared or worried about something, but Jesus is bigger than anything we face. He is always with us. He is stronger than every scary thing in this world.

1. Who was worried in our story?

Answer: Jairus was worried because his little girl was sick.

2. What special thing did Jesus do on the way to Jairus' house?

Answer: Healed a lady who was sick just by her touching his clothes!

3. When they got to Jairus' house, what did he do?

Answer: He healed Jairus' daughter.

4. Who can you trust?

Answer: I can trust Jesus

Parent: Talk about how you trust Jesus.

Prayer

Use this prayer as a guide, either after talking about the Bible story or sometime before bed tonight:

Dear Jesus, help us to seek You first in everything we do. We trust You with all our hearts. Amen.
