The Empty Tomb Changes Everything

Matthew 28:1–10

Big Idea

Because Jesus rose from the dead, everything changes—sin is defeated, death is conquered, and new life is available to all who believe.

Key Question

Is the tomb really empty?

I. The Tomb Was Real (Matthew 28:1)

Jesus truly died. The tomb was sealed and guarded.

II. The Stone Was Moved (Matthew 28:2)

The stone was moved so we could see in.

III. The Grave Was Empty (Matthew 28:5–6)

He is not here, for He has risen.

IV. The Savior Is Alive (Matthew 28:9)

Jesus appeared and is alive.

V. Everything Changes (1 Corinthians 15:17)

Sin is forgiven. Death is defeated. Hope is real.

Personal Response

Have I trusted Jesus? What needs to change?

Because the tomb is empty... you don't have to stay the same.
