# **Apostles Creed:**

## **Prayer of Confession:**

## **Scripture Reading: Psm. 130:1-8**

## **Scripture Reading: Ezk. 2:8-3:3**

The Lord gave specific instructions to Ezekiel. He was instructed to eat the scroll of God and once the scroll has been consumed, Ezekiel is asked to speak its truth. The Word of God should be consumed daily and its truth spoken often. What truth from God's Word can you speak this day?

## **Scripture Reading: Rev. 10:1-11**

The Lord has revealed his judgment to the nations. We are called to turn from sin and surrender fully to Christ. His mercy is great and His love has the power to break sin. What sin do you need to surrender?

## **Lord's Prayer**
