How do praise and trust in God's character strengthen our faith when we are facing difficult circumstances?

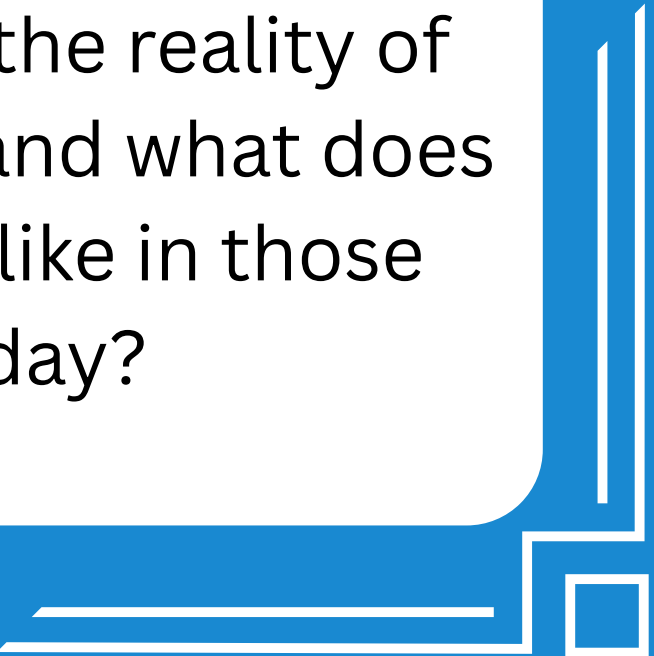


Scripture Reading: Jer. 42:18-22
