We only reap what has been sown

Galatians 6:7-9 (NLT) Don't be misled—you cannot mock the justice of God. You will always harvest what you plant. Those who live only to satisfy their own sinful nature will harvest decay and death from that sinful nature. But those who live to please the Spirit will harvest everlasting life from the Spirit.

We reap the same kind as we sow

We reap in proportion to what we sow

2 Corinthians 9:6 (NIV) Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously.

We reap more than we sow

Mark 4:8 (NIV) Still other seed fell on good soil. It came up, grew and produced a crop, some multiplying thirty, some sixty, some a hundred times.

We reap in a different season than we sow

“Too many believers are sowing wild oats throughout the week and then going to church on Sunday and praying for a crop failure.”

Ecclesiastes 3:1-2 (NLT) For everything there is a season, a time for every activity under heaven. A time to be born and a time to die. A time to plant and a time to harvest.
