



Wednesday, August 14

Bodybuilding 1 Corinthians 12:1-2, 4-6

Now concerning spiritual gifts, brothers and sisters, I do not want you to be uninformed. You know that when you were pagans, you were enticed and led astray to idols that could not speak. 4 Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit; ⁵ and there are varieties of services, but the same Lord; ⁶ and there are varieties of activities, but it is the same God who activates all of them in everyone. ⁷ To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good.

Notes – You need to know about spiritual gifts – they come from God, they differ in each of us but are all for a unified good purpose. How are you using your gifts to build up the body of Christ?

Prayer – Lord, awaken in me the knowledge and use of my spiritual gifts that might effectiveness for you may grow and be magnified for your glory.

Thursday, August 15

The power for Mission Acts 1:4-8

While staying with them, he ordered them not to leave Jerusalem, but to wait there for the promise of the Father. 'This', he said, 'is what you have heard from me; 5for John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now.' 6 So when they had come together, they asked him, 'Lord, is this the time when you will restore the kingdom to Israel?' 7He replied, 'It is not for you to know the times or periods that the Father has set by his own authority. 8But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.'

Notes – I used to love watching the old TV series "Mission Impossible". Every episode started with the word, "your mission, should you choose to accept it..." followed by the thrill of a new adventure. God has assigned us a mission, are you clear about what it is? Have you chosen to accept it? If so, what is your next step?

Prayer – Made for service for your kingdom and your kingdom alone, Lord, forgive me for using the powers and resources you have given me for selfish ends. Help me direct all my energy to faithfully completing the mission you have given me.

Friday, August 16

Together everyone achieves more Romans 12:4-6

For as in one body we have many members, and not all the members have the same function, so we, who are many, are one body in Christ, and individually we are members one of another. We have gifts that differ according to the grace given to us: prophecy, in proportion to faith;

Notes – If you ever lost the use of a part of your body you know how difficult it can be to complete some of the simplest tasks and don't even think about taking on a major project or challenge. When the body of Christ is one, strong, healthy, we can achieve more. As a church member where do you say "I can't do that"? Can you change that to "with God's help WE can do anything!"

Prayer – Lord, forgive me for every part of my life where I believe "it's all about me". Keep me in tune with your body so that I might use my gifts and abilities for your glory and the common good.



Serving God August 11 - Session 2 Gifted for Service

Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms. 1 Peter 4:10 CEB

How to discover your spiritual gifts

- > Believe that you have gifts. Every believer is given one or more gifts,
- Pray for God's leading.
- Study the Bible,
- Take a spiritual gifts class,
- Spend time getting to know Jesus,
- > Pay attention to the ministries that touch your heart,
- Try different things. Get involved. Do something,
- Judge your experiences—good and bad. Were you effective?
- Ask other people,
- > Identify the barriers and excuses that would keep you from discovering and using your gifts, and then remove them.

- When you allow the Holy Spirit to work through you to serve others, you bring glory to God.
- When we all do this together, we fully live into Jesus' plan for the church.

More about Passion – We can become excited or enthusiastic about something, but a passion is a deeper expression of our heart or comes from our soul and compels us to action. Like in the old cartoons when Popeye would eventually say, "that's all I can stands, I can't stands no more". Where does your broken heart lead you to compassionate service? Where does your sense of outrage at injustice lead you to help the vulnerable? Perhaps God's word burns in you and you can't stop yourself from proclaiming the good news with joy.

More about Church Ministry

– How it usually goes - someone thinks, "this would be a good thing for the church to do, the church has plenty of people so surely the pastor should be able to find someone to do this." We go to people, try to motivate them by convincing them that the task is not only important but is so important that they should give up something else in their lives and commit to this effort. And then we get frustrated (often with the pastor) when nothing gets done. "We keep talking about it but...." Instead – the body of Christ works best when a group of people naturally gather around a passion. They don't need to be recruited or convinced, they are passionate and they organize organically. But in order for this to take place **you need to know your passion and share it with others**.

Passion Categories

- **Celebration Ministries** The heart of these ministries is directed toward God by engaging the church in the Word, worship, song, the arts, etc.
- **Outreach Ministries** The heart of these ministries is focused on relating, reaching, and connecting unbelievers and the unchurched to a relationship with Christ and his church.
- **Connecting Ministries** The heart of these ministries is assimilating visitors, attenders, and members into a relationship with Christ and the church through hospitality, fellowship, belonging, and encouragement.
- **Equipping Ministries** -The heart of these ministries is maturing believers in the area of their gifts, ministry training, and leadership. It serves a variety of life-stage and affinity-based groups for growth, accountability, and service.
- **Caring Ministries** The heart of these ministries is assisting people in the church and community with their physical, emotional, relational, and spiritual health through the grace, love, and resources of the kingdom.
- **Supporting Ministries** The heart of these ministries is freeing other people, leaders, and ministries from practical concerns to keep focused on their ministry goals. They involve structuring the systems and procedures to serve and support people and ministries.



MADE FOR SERVICE TO OTHERS

Monday, August 12 Gifts for Glory 1 Peter 4:10

Like good stewards of the manifold grace of God, serve one another with whatever gift each of you has received.

Notes - In the movie Chariots of Fire the Olympic runner, Eric Liddell, says, "God made me fast ...and when I run, I feel His pleasure." What gifts has God given you to use with joy and thus please God?

Prayer - Lord, you call us to live fully, abundantly, using the gifts you have given us with pleasure in a way that delights You. I give who I am and all I have to You today to do with what you will.

Tuesday, August 13
The assurance of Help
John 15:26-27

'When the Advocate comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth who comes from the Father, he will testify on my behalf. You also are to testify because you have been with me from the beginning.

Notes - Yes, Christ calls us to follow and obedience does not mean the task is easy but in God's mercy we are given all we need.

Prayer - Today, Lord, let me not rely on my own spirit but on yours given to aid and guide me in my obedience to you.
