## THE KINGS ROYAL SUBJECT

"God's Desire"

## Philippians 3:1-14

#### INTRODUCTION:

- 1. When a couple is dating and they were getting along, and there was no doubt this was the right person, an emotional bond was developed.
  - a) Not Physical BUT Emotional!!!
  - b) And share your heart. Over time you develop a deep INTIMATE RELATIONSHIP.
- 2. **LISTEN UP**: If God designed us with a deep need and deep desire for INTIMACY in our human relationships, HOW MUCH MORE HE WANTS A CLOSE, COMMITTED RELATIONSHIP WITH US.
- 3. BUT far too often we PUSH God AWAY.
- 4. PSALM 148, 66:4
  - a) All of creation performs for God, but the intimacy of relationship with Him is reserved for the people who know Christ as Savior and our IDENTITY is in Christ.
    - 1) Galatians 2:20
- 5. **FACT IS**: GOD DESIRES EVEN YEARNS for an INTIMATE, SPIRITUAL, RELATIONSHIP with us.
- 6. **VERY IMPORTANT:** The capacity to draw close to another person and share your lives in such a way that you know each other inside out is part of the **IMAGE OF GOD** that we bear as emotional and relational human beings.
- 7. The reason it is so vital, is because true intimacy motivates us in all we do.
  - a) When you truly love your spouse, your spouse won't have to ask you to call, or to take out the trash, or to help around the house.
  - b) When two people know each other INTIMATELY, they are FREE TO BE THEMSELVES around each other.

#### I. IT STARTS WITH PASSION

#### A. A PASSION FOR SPIRITUAL INTIMACY

1. **Definition:** Passion is an all-consuming desire to draw closer to Jesus and to know Him more fully.

- 2. James 4:8
- 3. Philippians 3:1-2, 4-14
  - a) Vs 2
    - 1) "Look out for the dogs"
    - 2) "look out for the evildoers"
    - 3) "Look out for those who mutilate the flesh"
  - b) Paul is talking about the "Judaizers"
- 4. The **JUDAIZERS** were the religious elites trying to make the Philippians focus on "*rule keeping*" rather than on their personal relationship with Jesus.
  - a) Vs 3
    - 1) What a declaration of the value of knowing Christ over religious performance.
- 5. Vs 10
  - a) "and that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection."

### B. AN AUDIT OF ONE'S LIFES WORK

- 1. Philippians 3:4
  - a) Paul now gives his Resume' which was evidence of his credentials as a Jew of Jews.
- 2. Vs 5-6
- 3. Paul's religious upbringing was spotless.
  - a) He was from the tribe of Benjamin.
  - b) PAUL HAD ALL THE CREDENTIALS
    - 1) He was a Hebrew of Hebrews
- 4. "A Pharisee had reached the very summit of religious experience, the highest ideal a Jew could ever hope to attain."
- 5. Paul was a "Man on Fire" and was willing to round up the Christian Cult.
  - a) Acts 9:1-2

#### C. ONLY ONE THING MISSING

- 1. Paul didn't Know Jesus
- 2. Do you have any idea what that means?

# 3. Philippians 3:7

- 4. When Paul met Jesus on the Damascus Road, he had to leave all his religious pride and performance lying there in the dust.
- 5. WOW!!! Paul had to come to the realization all sinners must face, that the only way to heaven is found in a person, not a performance.

#### D. THE POWER TO LIVE FOR CHRIST

#### 1. Vs 8-9

- a) The power to live for Christ comes from knowing the Person of Christ...
  - 1)  $\dots$  and from receiving the righteousness that comes through faith in Him.
- 2. Paul gladly left behind his Superstar Status in Judaism because of his passion to know Christ intimately.

### II. THE PURSUIT OF KNOWING CHRIST

- 1. Galatians 2:20
- 2. Philippians 3:10 is another verse to build your life around.
  - a) "That I may know him and the power of his resurrection, and may share his sufferings, becoming like him in his death."

## A. A LIFELONG PURSUIT

1. As the Kings Royal Subjects, we are to Pursue Christ Intimately.

#### 2. 2 Corinthians 5:16

- 3. After his conversion, Paul truly came to know the Lord, because he became a new creature in Christ.
  - a) **QUESTION**: Why is it that some Christians have Victory while others are defeated?
  - b) **ANSWER**: Because Victorious Christians know Christ more intimately and because of that they experience His resurrection power, that is transferred to the King's Royal Subjects (disciples).

a) A lot of us Christians would like to put a period after "That I may know the power of his resurrection" Period!!

#### B. SHARING CHRIST'S SUFFERINGS

- 1. Vs 10
  - a) BUT THE VERSE CONTINUES: "and may share his sufferings, becoming like him in death."
- 2. VERY IMPORTANT: We are called to share in Christ's suffering!!!
- 3. All that meant Paul had a special kind of intimacy that drew him close.
  - a) If we are going to know Christ with the kind of intimacy that draws us close, we must know Him in the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death.
  - b) WHAT DOES THAT MEAN?
    - 1) It means that we are called to share in Christ's sufferings!!
    - 2) Paull suffered for sharing the GOSPEL
  - c) MOST CHRISTIANS WANT A FOUR STEP PROGRAM OF DISCIPLESHIP
    - a) Read your Bible
    - b) Pray
    - c) Attend Church if it doesn't interfere with anything else.
    - d) Serve now and then
  - d) Ephesians 2:10
- 4. **LISTEN UP**: The problem is that we think LISTS HAVE SOME SPECIAL KIND OF POWER that they don't have.
- 5. **VERY IMPORTANT**: REAL POWER comes when the LIVING WORD, JESUS CHRIST, connects with the IMPLANTED WORD in our souls.
- 6. THIS IS BIG: THAT'S CALLED ABIDING
