## THE KINGS ROYAL SUBJECTS

# "Abiding in Christ" John 15:1-10

#### INTRODUCTION:

- 1. John 15:1-10
- 2. Jesus spoke these words in the Upper Room just before His Crucifixion.
- 3. Jn 15:1-2
- 4. In these verses we see Jesus using familiar language to get His point across.
  - a) The disciples knew all about VINES and FRUIT. (Horticulture)
  - b) The question was, "How were they to produce the fruit that God desired?"
- 5. Verses 4-5
- 6. Fruit has 3 characteristics:
  - a) First Fruit always bears the character of the tree of which it is part.
    - 1) Pear trees don't bear apples.
  - b) Second Fruit is always available
  - c) Third Fruit exists for the benefit of others.
    - 1) Fruit trees don't eat fruit.
    - 2) Therefore, kingdom disciples make disciples, producing fruit in the lives of others. Vs 8
- 7. There may be times when believers stop bearing fruit.
  - a) For whatever reason.
    - 1) 2 Timothy 4:10
    - 2) Colossians 4:14
    - 3) Philemon 23-24
- 8. In **John 15** we must begin by asking some questions. (Good Hermeneutics)
  - a) Who is Jesus talking to? The saved disciples
  - b) What's Jesus talking about? Bearing Fruit
  - c) When? When He is gone Cf. 14:12-14
  - d) Why? To bring Glory to the Father 14:13; 15:8
- 9. John 15 is not about salvation. It's about BEARING FRUIT.
- 10. God's Desire is Intimacy with His Disciples.
  - a) Philippians 3

11. **INTIMACY** - Passion is an all-consuming desire to draw close to Jesus and to know Him more fully.

#### I. INTIMACY IS VITAL TO FRUIT BEARING

- A. THE VINE Jesus
  - 1. Vs 1
    - a) "I am the vine"
      - 1) This is the last of Jesus 7 "I AM" statements in John.
  - 2. Cf. 14:28-31
    - a) "Rise, let us go from here"
  - 3. Jesus; the VINE, is the source of all spiritual fruit.

#### B. THE VINEDRESSER

- 1. Vs 1
  - a) "and My Father is the Vinedresser"
- 2. The vinedresser's job is to make sure the vine produces as much fruit as possible.
  - a) He **prunes**
  - b) He **cultivates**
  - c) He trains
- 3. The Father is the one who, is in charge of the vineyard.
- C. THE BRANCHES The disciples (believers) "The Kings Royal Subjects"
  - 1. Now this is where people get messed up in their interpretation.
    - a) A TEXT out of CONTEXT is a PRETEXT
  - 2. Vs 2a
    - a) "Every branch in me"
      - 1) "in" a preposition describing location
    - b) "...that does not bear fruit he takes away"
      - 1) Just simply means that these branches are worthless!!

- 3. Vs 5
  - a) "you (disciples) are the branches."
    - 1) "you" is stated no less than 15 times
- 4. Who are the branches?
  - a) Believers!!!!
- 5 Vs 3
  - a) "clean" means saved
  - b) Cf. 13:6-10
    - 1) "You are clean"
  - c) "because of the word"
- 6. Vs 5
  - a) "that does not bear fruit"
    - 1) Not false converts.
    - 2) Not believers losing their salvation.
    - 3) These are believers who are worthless.
- 7.1 Corinthians 3:10-15
  - a) 2 Corinthians 5:10
- 8. "The Security of the Believer."
  - a) Ephesians 2:8-9
  - b) **Ephesians 4:30**
  - c) 2 Corinthians 13:5

#### II. REMAINING IN THE VINE IS KEY TO INTIMACY

- WOW Vs 7
  - a) "ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you"

#### A. WHERE PRAYERS GET ANSWERED

- 1. THAT IS HUGE: Authority in prayer.... is the practical manifestation of the Kings authority.
  - a) WOW!!!! Heaven obligates itself to respond to believers who are the Kings Royal Subjects (His disciples) when they invoke God's presence in the affairs of this life.
- 2. **LISTEN UP**: It should not surprise a believer to see the supernatural operating in the natural!!!

#### B. OUR CONNECTION TO CHRIST IS THE KEY

- 1. As Branches we are to Bear Fruit, BUT the life-giving substance flows to you from the VINE.
- 2. Where does the INTIMACY come from?
  - a) It comes from "ABIDING IN CHRIST"
- 3. To ABIDE or to remain or to stay in connection.

#### II. HOW INTIMACY WORKS

- 1. John 15:7
  - a) "If you abide in me, and my words abide in you,"
  - b) "ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you."
- 2. **THAT'S AMAZING**: Jesus says that if we abide, or remain, in Him and keep His words in us, then we can ask to be set free from an addiction, a wrong attitude, an oppressive relationship, or anything that is contrary to His will.
- 3. When you get close to Jesus as His faithful disciple, He will amaze you by what He will do in you and through you.
- 4. So, after we have received God's Word, James tells us to be "doers of the word."
- 5. James 1:23-25
  - a) James tells us that we should approach the scriptures like a woman looks at a mirror-checking out the details.
- 6. We are to take our time to **meditate on verses**, until the HOLY SPIRIT affects our souls with the transforming power of the TRUTH of God's word!!!
- 7. James 1:25 WOW
- 8. When we abide in God's Word and depend on the Holy Spirit, spiritual transformation is inevitable.
  - a) 2 Corinthians 3:17-18

## III. HANGING OUT IN THE WORD

- 1. John 8:31
  - a) "If you abide in my word, you are truly my disciples."
- 2. Hanging out with the Lord in His word, it's like someone recharging their cellphone at the end of the day.

# **CONCLUSION:**

- 1. By identifying with Christ through an INTIMATE, ABIDING RELATIONSHIP
  - a) of FELLOWSHIPPING in His Sufferings,
  - b) Conforming to His CHARACTER, and ABIDING IN HIS WORDS,
  - c) you can live as one of the KINGS ROYAL SUBJECTS.
