# THE KING"S ROYAL SUBJECTS

"Upsetting the World"

Matthew 28:19-20

## **INTRODUCTION:**

- 1. The theme of the Bible is: The King and the Kingdom!!
  - a) And we (Believers) are His Royal Subjects.
- 2. A "Royal Subject" is someone who owes Loyalty and Obedience to the Crown.
  - a) And "What's Missing?" is that Royal Subjects are in SHORT SUPPLY.
- 3. After Jesus rose from the dead, He took steps to ensure that there would be "Faithful Followers."
  - a) So He called a meeting -
    - 1) Matthew 28:16-20
  - b) Who was called to the meeting?
    - 1) The disciples
    - 2) No doubt the 500 who witnessed His Resurrection in 1 Cor. 15
    - 3) Vs 20 all believers until He returns.
  - c) The Minutes of the meeting read -
    - 1) Vs 18-20
    - 2) *Luke 19:11-13* KJV Parable Is about our eternal rewards!! Not Salvation
      - a) "Occupy till I come"
      - b) Means to do business till He comes
      - c) That means to invest and make a profit.
- 4. **VERY IMPORTANT**: A disciple (Royal Subject) is a person who has decided that following Jesus takes **PRECIDENCE OVER EVERYTHING ELSE**.
- 5. THAT'S WHY OUR FOCUS HAS TO BE ON DISCIPLESHIP
- 6. Matthew 28:16-18, 19
  - a) "making disciples of all nations"

#### I. EXERCISING DOMINION

- 1. The Disciples were not just sent out to PLANT CHURCHES.
  - a) But to EXERCISE DOMINION.

- 2. Acts 4:1-13
- 3. Acts 17:6
- 4. What happened to change their lives so radically?
  - a) Acts 1:6-11, 12-15
- 5. **HERE'S A BIG QUESTION**: Do you realize that Christ has commanded us to impact our communities?
  - a) Jesus doesn't want CROSSROADS just to be another church!!!!
    - 1) Jesus wants this church to make an impact.
- 6. **TODAY** The world is ignoring Christians and the Church in countless ways, because the lost world is not witnessing the POWER and Authority we speak about. Sing about. And preach about.

# 7. WHAT WE NEED ARE PEOPLE WHO ARE ON FIRE FOR JESUS

- a) People who have a burning desire to serve Him.
  - 1) 2 Timothy 1:6 NLT
- b) People who are so excited about Him that they shake up the church and the community.
- 8.1 Peter 4:12
  - a) Tribulation is a part of the Christian experience, or it isn't the Christian experience.
- 9. VERY IMPORTANT:
  - a) If Satan never bothers you....you better check the direction you are going.

#### II. WE ARE SLAVES TO CHRIST

- 1. Ephesians 6:5-6 NLT
  - a) "slaves" -
- 2. The task of the Slave Duplicator Unit is not to create it's own message, or to distort the message it is receiving, but to duplicate what is on the Master.
- 3. THAT'S EXACTLY WHAT A DISCIPLE IS TO DO!!
  - a) Jesus is the Master, and we are His Slaves, with the task of duplicating His Character and Conduct and Authority in history.

- 4. **WOW!!!** It is through the mass producing of disciples that will fulfill God's original intent to reach mankind.
- 5. The word "Disciple" means learner, student.
- 6. Matthew 10:24-25 NLT
  - a) Describes what a disciple should look like.

# III. THE INTENTION OF DISCIPLESHIP

- 1. The intention of discipleship is conformity to the Savior, being transformed into the image and likeness of Christ.
  - a) Romans 8:29
  - b) 2 Corinthians 3:17-18
- 2. Transformed in character, conduct, attitudes and actions.
- 3. Discipleship also results in the exercise of authority through us in the world.
- 4. In the same way, people ought to be able to tell by the way you walk; and by the way you talk, by the total orientation of your life, that you belong to Jesus.
  - a) And the conclusion is that the believer belongs to Christ.
  - b) There is a family resemblance.

# IV. THE JESUS PLAN

- A Disciple is a person who has decided that following Jesus takes PRECIDENCE over everything else.
- LET'S LOOK AT THE THREE STEP JESUS PLAN -
- Matthew 28:19-20
- A. STEP ONE "GO"
  - 1. Vs 19
    - a) "Go therefore"
      - 1) Literally means "Go, and as you go make disciples"
  - 2. **VERY IMPORTANT:** The nations are not told to come Christians for the Gospel.

3. Please Listen Up: Christians are not doing the work of the Church if we are not winning souls to Christ and bearing public witness to the message of the Gospel.

#### 4. Acts 1:8

a) The absence of evangelism is proof positive that the work of the Spirit is NOT OCURRING in the life of a believer or church.

## 5.1 Corinthians 15:1-6

- 6. Evangelism is done with the clear intent of bringing the hearer to faith in Jesus Christ for Salvation.
- 7. The church then is to challenge, encourage, and equip members to effectively share their faith with unbelievers.

## B. STEP TWO - "BAPTIZING THEM"

- 1. Vs 19
  - a) "baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit."
- 2. The primary meaning is "identification"
- 3. It means to be placed into.
  - a) "baptizo" -

## 4. Romans 6:3-4

- 5. When we put our trust in Christ, we become so completely identified with Him, that His death and resurrection become our death and resurrection.
  - a) Water baptism pictures a believer dying to the old life and resurrecting to a new way of life.

#### C. STEP THREE - TEACHING BIBLICAL TRUTH

#### 1. Vs 20

- a) "Teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you"
- 2. What does that mean?
  - a) Way too many Christians want to AUDIT the Christian life,

- 1) They want the information without the testing and responsibility.
- 3. Information must be combined with obedience.
  - a) Accountability must be a key component, since obedience is the goal.
- 4. The goal of Biblical teaching is to combine information and knowledge with skill in applying the truth to daily life.

# CONCLUSION: MAKING A DECISION

- 1. Notice Vs 20
  - a) "and behold I am with you always to the end of the age"
- 2. That my friends is not a promise to all believers, but to those who are disciple makers.
- 3. The greater and deeper the discipleship, the greater the access to kingdom authority.
