# THE KINGS ROYAL SUBJECTS "The Priority of the Church" - Part 3 Acts 2:42-47

#### INTRODUCTION:

- 1. <u>Discipleship is the Process of the Local Church that seeks to bring believers from Spiritual Infancy to Spiritual Maturity.</u>
- 2. The LOCAL CHURCH that supplies the FIVE VITAL EXPERIENCES the Church is purposed to do, will lead believers in becoming FAITHFUL FOLLOWERS OF CHRIST (Disciples).
  - a) A Dynamic Witness
  - b) Knowledge of the Word A hunger for the Word!!
  - c) Devoted Fellowship
  - d) God Honoring Praise and Worship
  - e) Serving Others

## III. The THIRD VITAL CHURCH EXPERIENCE - DEVOTED FELLOWSHIP

- Acts 2:42
  - a) "and they devoted themselves"
    - 1) "devoted" means to stay close, endure, or to persist.

It means to pursue intently

- b) "they devoted themselves to the apostles teaching and the fellowship,"
  - 1) Gk. "Koinonia" means have something in common.
  - 2) It means to mutually share the life of Christ within the family of God

# A. HELPING TO MEET NEEDS

- 1 John 15:12
  - a) We are called to "love one another"
- 2. Galatians 6:2
  - a) We are called "to carry one another's burdens"
- 3. Ephesians 4:32
  - a) We are called "to forgive one another"
- 4. A disconnected Christian is a disobedient and unfruitful Christian.

- 5. **FELLOWSHIP** is the sharing of our lives with other believers.
- 6. Acts 2:44-45
  - a) These believers were sharing possessions and meeting needs.

## B. PARTICIPATION NECESSARY

- 1. True discipleship can happen only by being an active participant in community with other believers.
  - a) Ephesians 4:16
  - b) 1 Corinthians 12
- 2. Notice what the writer of Hebrews has to say Hebrews 10:24-25
- 3. Therefore an "Unchurched" believer is a disobedient believer.
  - a) When a believer is willfully disobedient, their spiritual growth (maturity) is hindered.
- 4. Jeremiah 20:9
- 5. VERY IMPORTANT: We need each other because (Matthew 26:41).
- 6. 1 Corinthians 10:12

## C. RELATIONSHIPS ARE DIFFICULT

- 1. Entertainment is easy....
  - a) All you have to do is sit in a chair with a remote and lean back.
  - b) Far too many individuals and families are camping out in front of Social Media platforms.
    - 1) You Tube videos.
    - 2) Podcasts.
    - 3) TV programs.
  - c) Cellphones are relationship killers.

# 2. FELLOWSHIP doesn't just happen!!!

- a) It takes hard work and effort.
- b) Sometimes you have to set some time aside to cultivate friendships.

# D. JESUS IS PART OF THE CONVERSATION

- 1. Christian Fellowship isn't happening if Jesus isn't part of the conversation.
- 2. **BIBLICAL FELLOWSHIP is ALWAYS DESIGNED** to spur one another on to spirituality.

### 3. TRUE BIBLICAL FELLOWSHIP ALWAYS HAS A SPIRITUAL GOAL:

a) The mutual sharing of Christ!!!

#### 4. Acts 2:46

- a) "breaking bread in their homes"
  - 1) Sometimes food is involved.

#### 5. Revelation 19:9

- a) One Day we will be seated @ The Marriage Supper of the Lamb and celebrate and enjoy fellowship in Heaven.
- 6. When we have true biblical fellowship....
  - a) we should leave feeling encouraged and refreshed in the faith.

## E. FELLOWSHIP INCLUDES ACCOUNTABILITY

- 1. Ephesians 4:11-16
  - a) "Builds itself up"
- 2. Romans 12:4-6
- 3. A body can only function properly when all parts are connected and mutually supporting and serving each other.
- 4. The absence Accountability to mature believers in the church means true discipleship is not occurring.

#### IV. PRAISE AND WORSHIP

- Acts 2:42
  - a) "breaking of bread and the prayers"
    - 1) That would be WORSHIP
- Acts 2:46
  - a) "day by day attending the temple."
- Acts 2:47

- a) "praising God"
- AND their selfishness began to fall by the wayside.
  - a) Vs 44-45

## A. THE FURNACE OF SPIRITUAL LIFE

- Worship is acknowledging God for who He is and what He has done and will do.
   a) GOD IS THE FOCUS OF WORSHIP
- 2. WORSHIP IS NOT ABOUT "What you can get out of it!!"
- 3. God responds to our worship!!!
  - a) Psalm 22:3
    - 1) Praising God's name ushers God's presence into even the darkest of moments.
  - b) And with His presence comes His character:
    - 1) His love; peace; kindness; joy; truth; security; faithfulness.
  - c) Hebrews 4:14-15

# B. ALWAYS A REASON TO WORSHIP

- 1. Philippians 4:6
- 2. If we want God's power in our lives, then WORSHIP must be part of our daily routine.

# C. IT'S A GUARANTEE

- 1. When we Experience: A Dynamic Witness; Biblical Teaching; Fellowship and WORSHIP, it is a guaranteed that we are moving forward in our DISCIPLESHIP.
- 2. Be mindful of Christians who ignore one or more of these experiences.
- 3. BUT WHEN WE SUBMIT TO THE HOLY SPIRIT and participate in all these EXPERIENCES.....SOMETHING EXCITING IS ABOUT TO HAPPEN.
  - a) That's a GUARANTEE
- 4. Acts 2:43
  - a) "awe" that's a healthy dose of reverential FEAR
  - b) Webster: It's an overwhelming sense of reverence and respect.

- 5. **Vs 43** 
  - a) "and many wonders and signs were being done through the apostles.
- 6. Vs 47
  - a) "and the Lord added to their number day by day those who were being saved."
