- Healed a paralyzed man in Capernaum
- Healed a man with a deformed hand

What happens when we walk by sight?

What happens when we walk by faith?

- We trust in God for a positive outcome despite no evidence to suggest it.

What happens when we walk by sight?

- We will settle for comfort and contentment instead of walking in obedience and favor.

What happens when we walk by faith?

- We become convinced that whatever God has for us is better than what we could do or accomplish on our own.

What happens when we walk by sight?

- It creates an unwillingness or apprehensiveness to go into the unknown.

What happens when we walk by faith?

- We allow Him to lead us, even when we don't know where we are going.
