Discussion

- 1. Who is Paul speaking to in this Chapter?
- 2. What does Paul describe as the "mystery" of Christ?
- 3. Why do you think it is easy to SAY that all people should be unified in Christ, but not always easy to live that out?
- 4. What does verse 18 mean to you? (speaking of Christ's love)
- 5. What does loving others "wide and long and high and deep" look like day to day?
- 6. What is your dream for God's church?

Bible Exploration

- Paul explains the "mystery" of Christ (3:2-6)
- Paul speaks on his responsibility to share this "mystery" with the Gentiles (3:7-12)
- Paul prays that the Ephesians experience Christ's love and show it to one another (3:14-21)

Deeper Walk: Apply it Challenge

1. Pray every day for the future of God's church

- a. Look at the Vision and Mission card every day
- b. Ask God how you can be a part of this vision and mission
- c. Ask God to open your mind and heart to all people

2. Invite someone to dinner that is not a part of your close friendship group

- a. Ask them about themselves
- b. Find out their needs

- b. Show your community Christ's love
- c. Pray for your community
