

Discussion Questions - Session 7

1. In looking back on the series, do you believe that God created you to be holy and blameless. If so, what have you changed or improved upon in your life?

Ephesians 1:4 - For he chose us in him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in his sight.

2. Have you honestly grown in your love for God? If so, how?

Mark 12:30 - Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength.

3. What has changed in your life over the past several months to improve the Family of God?

Eph. 2:19 - Consequently, you are no longer foreigners and aliens, but fellow citizens with God's people and members of God's household.

4. How has your efforts help in building up the body of Christ?

Eph. 4:11-13 - It was he who gave some to be apostles, some to be prophets, some to be evangelists, and some to be pastors and teachers, to prepare God's people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ.

5. Have you found what God has called you to do and how much effort are you putting in with using it?

Eph. 2:10 - For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

6. How well have you been in meeting together with all the saints? Are you helping building others up?

Hebrews 10:25 - Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.
