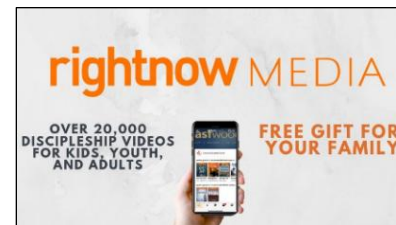

1. What was the main thing you learned from the sermon?
2. What questions do you have about anything that was raised during the message?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What answers have you heard people say to define the meaning of life?
2. In what ways have you sought for meaning outside of Christ?
3. In what ways did Jesus *not* fulfill the expectation of a Jewish Messiah?
4. How does the fact that women were the first to report the empty tomb lend credibility to the Biblical account?
5. Why do you think God used angels to tell the women what happened to Jesus?
6. What does it show about the disciples that they didn't believe the women's story?
7. How does the question of “the meaning of life” fall short until we insert the word “eternal?”
8. Why did God deliver Jesus into the hands of sinful men?
9. How does the resurrection of Jesus give us meaning both to earthly and eternal life?
