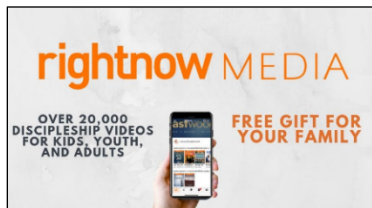

SCRIPTURE REFERENCES (NASB unless otherwise noted)

Matthew 26:36-46

³⁶ Then Jesus came with them to a place called Gethsemane, and told His disciples, “Sit here while I go over there and pray.” ³⁷ And He took Peter and the two sons of Zebedee with Him, and began to be grieved and distressed. ³⁸ Then He said to them, “My soul is deeply grieved, to the point of death; remain here and keep watch with Me.” ³⁹ And He went a little beyond *them*, and fell on His face and prayed, saying, “My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from Me; yet not as I will, but as You *will*.” ⁴⁰ And He came to the disciples and found them sleeping, and He said to Peter, “So, you *men* could not keep watch with Me for one hour? ⁴¹ Keep watching and praying, so that you do not come into temptation; the spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak.” ⁴² He went away again a second time and prayed, saying, “My Father, if this *cup* cannot pass away unless I drink *from* it, Your will be done.” ⁴³ Again He came and found them sleeping, for their eyes were heavy. ⁴⁴ And He left them again, and went away and prayed a third time, saying the same thing once more. ⁴⁵ Then He came to the disciples and said to them, “Are you still sleeping and resting? Behold, the hour is at hand and the Son of Man is being betrayed into the hands of sinners. ⁴⁶ Get up, let’s go; behold, the one who is betraying Me is near!”

OPENING DISCUSSION

1. What was the main thing you learned from the sermon?
2. What questions do you have about anything that was raised during the message?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS :

1. How does Jesus' actions in Gethsemane reflect both His humanity and divinity?
2. In what ways can we better support each other in our spiritual difficulties? What role does intercessory prayer play in the life of a believer?
3. What triggers restlessness in your life.. Anxiety? Conflict? Uncertainty? How do we fight against the temptation to run during those times?
4. How do we ensure that our spirit remains willing even when our flesh is weak?
5. What are some escapes we might be using to avoid facing our own Gethsemane moments?
6. How can we recognize when we are spiritually aloof or 'sleeping' in our faith? Why is community important in that process?
7. What steps can we take to establish a healthy routine of prayer and communion with God?
