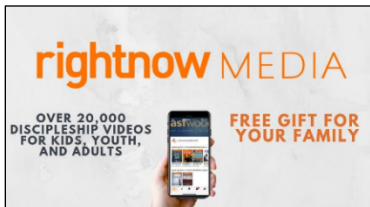

OPENING DISCUSSION

1. What was the main thing you learned from the sermon?
2. What questions do you have about anything that was raised during the message?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS :

1. In what ways does Jesus' interaction with the blind men illustrate His teaching of Kingdom values?
2. How does the servant heart demonstrated by Jesus challenge modern understandings of greatness?
3. How can we apply the blind men's persistence in seeking Jesus to our own spiritual lives?
4. Where might you find examples of the crowd mentality today? How can we encourage others to confront their blind spots?
5. How is biblical love and compassion different than how the world might define it?
6. What practical steps can you take to ensure you are pursuing Christ like compassion in your daily interactions?
7. How have you seen expectations hinder true Kingdom living within the church today?
8. What does it mean for us to follow Jesus 'with eyes wide open' in your personal walk of faith? How does this particularly relate to our relationship with others?
