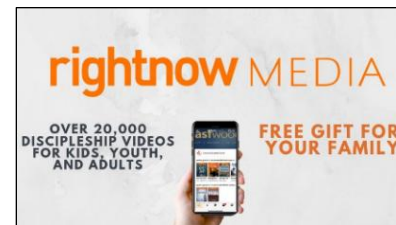

SCRIPTURE REFERENCES (NASB unless otherwise noted)

Matthew 22:1-14

¹⁵ Then the Pharisees went and plotted together how they might trap Him in what He said. ¹⁶ And they sent their disciples to Him, along with the Herodians, saying, “Teacher, we know that You are truthful and teach the way of God in truth, and do not care what anyone thinks; for You are not partial to anyone. ¹⁷ Tell us then, what do You think? Is it permissible to pay a poll-tax to Caesar, or not?” ¹⁸ But Jesus perceived their malice, and said, “Why are you testing Me, you hypocrites? ¹⁹ Show Me the coin *used* for the poll-tax.” And they brought Him a denarius. ²⁰ And He said to them, “Whose image and inscription is this?” ²¹ They said to Him, “Caesar’s.” Then He said to them, “Then pay to Caesar the things that are Caesar’s; and to God the things that are God’s.” ²² And hearing *this*, they were amazed; and they left Him and went away.

²³ On that day *some* Sadducees (who say there is no resurrection) came to Jesus and questioned Him, ²⁴ saying, “Teacher, Moses said, ‘If a man dies having no children, his brother as next of kin shall marry his wife, and raise up children for his brother.’ ²⁵ Now there were seven brothers among us; and the first married and died, and having no children, he left his wife to his brother. ²⁶ *It was* the same also *with* the second *brother*, and the third, down to the seventh. ²⁷ Last of all, the woman died. ²⁸ In the resurrection, therefore, whose wife of the seven will she be? For they all had her *in marriage*.”

²⁹ But Jesus answered and said to them, “You are mistaken, since you do not understand the Scriptures nor the power of God. ³⁰ For in the resurrection they neither marry nor are given in marriage, but are like angels in heaven. ³¹ But regarding the resurrection of the dead, have you not read what was spoken to you by God: ³² ‘I AM THE GOD OF ABRAHAM, THE GOD OF ISAAC, AND THE GOD OF JACOB’? He is not the God of the dead, but of the living.” ³³ When the crowds heard *this*, they were astonished at His teaching.

OPENING DISCUSSION

1. What was the main thing you learned from the sermon?
2. What questions do you have about anything that was raised during the message?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Name some ways that mankind is made in the image of God.
2. How has sin distorted that image of God in us?
3. The Pharisees and Herodians tried to trap Jesus with a question designed to make Him show loyalty to either God or the government. Describe any experiences you’ve had with unbelievers/skeptics where they have questioned your beliefs.
4. Jesus corrected the Sadducees by saying they lacked understanding about God’s Word and God’s power. In what ways can we gain better understanding of God’s Word & power?
5. How will we be the same, and how will we be different in Heaven?
6. How will our relationship with others be the same, and how will they be different in Heaven?
7. Discuss the idea of man as “spirit, soul and body” (1 Thessalonians 5:23). How is it helpful (or confusing) to think of man this way?
8. What is sanctification and how do we participate in that process?
9. How do you see God’s image displayed in your life?
