

SCRIPTURE REFERENCES (NASB unless otherwise noted)

📖 Matthew 17:14-23

14 When they came to the crowd, a man came up to Jesus, falling on his knees before Him and saying,

15 “Lord, have mercy on my son, because he has seizures and suffers terribly; for he often falls into the fire and often into the water.

16 And I brought him to Your disciples, and they could not cure him.”

17 And Jesus answered and said, “You unbelieving and perverse generation, how long shall I be with you? How long shall I put up with you? Bring him here to Me.”

18 And Jesus rebuked him, and the demon came out of him, and the boy was healed at once.

19 Then the disciples came to Jesus privately and said, “Why could we not cast it out?”

20 And He said to them, “Because of your meager faith; for truly I say to you, if you have faith the size of a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, ‘Move from here to there,’ and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you.”

22 And while they were gathering together in Galilee, Jesus said to them, “The Son of Man is going to be handed over to men;

23 and they will kill Him, and He will be raised on the third day.” And they were deeply grieved.

OPENING DISCUSSION

1. What was the main thing you learned from the sermon?
2. What questions do you have about anything that was raised during the message?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What do you think it was like for the father of the boy when the disciples were unable to cure him?
2. Name as many reasons as you can of why God might not heal someone.
3. Why is it not enough to have the authority of God to perform the works of God (healing, etc.) . . . what else is necessary?
4. What have you prayed for over a long period of time and what have you learned from that?
5. Why do you think Jesus condemned the whole “unbelieving and perverse generation” at this moment (Matthew 17:17)?
6. How might someone have a sufficient *amount* of faith but a deficient *quality* of faith?
7. How does growing closer in relationship to God help us mature in our prayers?
8. How would you counsel someone whose deep grief has clouded them from seeing the goodness of God?
9. How does the resurrection offer us proof of God’s ultimate goodness?
