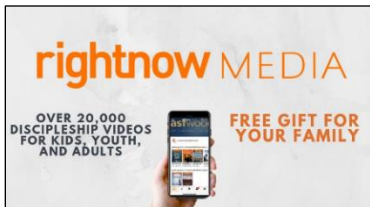

OPENING DISCUSSION

1. What was the main thing you learned from the sermon?

1. What is the difference between trusting God and merely believing He exists?
2. Why do people often struggle to trust God completely?
3. What situations make it hardest for you to trust the Lord?
4. What is meant by “lean not unto thine own understanding”?
5. How does trusting God bring peace during uncertainty?
6. What practical steps can help you trust God more fully?
7. How can our understanding sometimes conflict with God’s wisdom?
8. What gave God the confidence to say to Satan, ‘Have you considered My servant Job?’
9. “When Job lost his children, livestock, wealth, and health, why did he choose to worship God instead of blaming Him?”
10. How can a strong relationship with God help you in times of trouble? And how can a lack of a relationship with God cause you to stumble and fall when hard times arise?
