



SCRIPTURE REFERENCES (NASB unless otherwise noted)

1 Corinthians 9:6-15

6 Now I say this: the one who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and the one who sows generously will also reap generously.

7 Each one must do just as he has decided in his heart, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.

8 And God is able to make all grace overflow to you, so that, always having all sufficiency in everything, you may have an abundance for every good deed;

9 as it is written: "HE SCATTERED ABROAD, HE GAVE TO THE POOR, HIS RIGHTEOUSNESS ENDURES FOREVER."

10 Now He who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will supply and multiply your seed for sowing and increase the harvest of your righteousness;

11 you will be enriched in everything for all liberality, which through us is producing thanksgiving to God.

12 For the ministry of this service is not only fully supplying the needs of the saints, but is also overflowing through many thanksgivings to God.

13 Because of the proof given by this ministry, they will glorify God for your obedience to your confession of the gospel of Christ and for the liberality of your contribution to them and to all,

14 while they also, by prayer on your behalf, yearn for you because of the surpassing grace of God in you.

15 Thanks be to God for His indescribable gift!

1. How is our ability to give connected to God's grace?
2. How is our willingness to give connected to our understanding of God's grace?
3. How does the principle of "sowing and reaping" apply to our giving?
4. How does knowing that God is the "supplier" and we are the "sower" give us perspective on giving?
5. How does the truth that God will ensure we have "all sufficiency in everything" help bring us security when we give?
6. In what ways, other than monetarily, might you reap bountifully after sowing bountifully? (vs. 10-11)
7. How do you apply grace to all of life, not just to your salvation?
8. How is the principle of "sowing and reaping" not about being rich materially, but being rich in generosity?
9. How does learning to be a gracious sower lead to overflowing thankfulness?
10. How do you become a cheerful giver?
