SCRIPTURE REFERENCES (NASB unless otherwise noted)

Matthew 11:20-30

²⁰ Then He began to reprimand the cities in which most of His miracles were done, because they did not repent. ²¹ “Woe to you, Chorazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida! For if the miracles that occurred in you had occurred in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented long ago in sackcloth and ashes. ²² Nevertheless I say to you, it will be more tolerable for Tyre and Sidon on the day of judgment than for you. ²³ And you, Capernaum, will not be exalted to heaven, will you? You will be brought down to Hades! For if the miracles that occurred in you had occurred in Sodom, it would have remained to this day. ²⁴ Nevertheless I say to you that it will be more tolerable for the land of Sodom on the day of judgment, than for you.” ²⁵ At that time Jesus said, “I praise You, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that You have hidden these things from the wise and intelligent, and have revealed them to infants. ²⁶ Yes, Father, for this way was well pleasing in Your sight. ²⁷ All things have been handed over to Me by My Father; and no one knows the Son except the Father; nor does anyone know the Father except the Son, and anyone to whom the Son determines to reveal Him. ²⁸ “Come to Me, all who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. ²⁹ Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and YOU WILL FIND REST FOR YOUR SOULS. ³⁰ For My yoke is comfortable, and My burden is light.”

Jeremiah 6:16

This is what the Lord says: “Stand by the ways and see and ask for the ancient paths, where the good way is, and walk in it; then you will find a resting place for your souls. But they said, ‘We will not walk in it.’

OPENING DISCUSSION

1. What was the main thing you learned from the sermon?
2. What questions do you have about anything that was raised during the message?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS :

1. Why does Jesus present such a drastic comparison (to places like Sodom) to these people who witnessed his ministry firsthand?
2. Have you ever been tempted to follow your own knowledge and rationale over God’s? How so?
3. Is there a difference between child-like faith and childish faith? Why might this be an important distinction?
4. Are there particular areas in your own life that you tend to resist wisdom or correction in?
5. Where in the modern church might we struggle with the propensity to build up our own understanding and judgements about how things should be?
6. What practical steps can you take to submit to the “yoke” of Jesus and learn from Him? What prevents you from walking submissively?
7. How can the community of believers help one another retain a teachable heart under Christ?
8. Where do you turn to in times of weariness and burden? Why might the promised rest here be different than we expect or anticipate?
