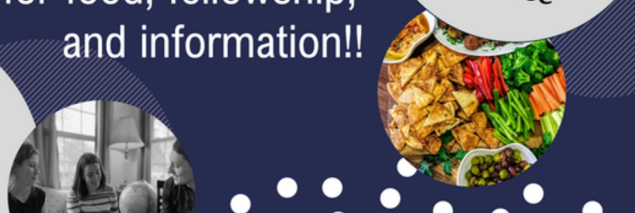

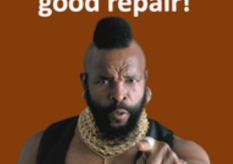

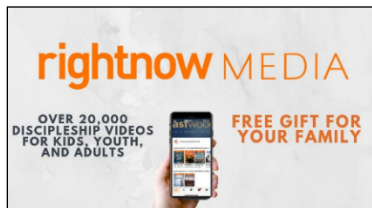

OPENING DISCUSSION

1. What was the main thing you learned from the sermon?
2. What questions do you have about anything that was raised during the message?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1. Why do you think Jesus used the example of servants managing their master's resources?
2. How does knowing that God assigns such value to people affect your evangelism and discipleship?
3. If God entrusts each person according to their ability, how can you discover the gifts and abilities He has given you?
4. Why do you think both the servant with five talents and the servant with two talents received the same praise? What areas of your life require greater faithfulness?
5. Fear can keep us from our purpose. What fears in your life have kept you from serving God more fully?
6. God expects growth. In what ways have you grown spiritually over the past year?
7. What does it mean to be accountable to God? And how can this be possible?
8. What changes do you need to make so that you can hear, "Well done, good and faithful servant"?
9. If Jesus returned today, would He find you investing what He entrusted to you? Or would He find it buried? What will you do this week to faithfully use what God has placed in your hands?
