5 Areas to Fortify for 2026

1. Strategic Prayer. Recon Teams/Gather Intel, Develop Plans, Assign Responsibilities and Launch!
 - a. 12 Spies (10 gave a negative report): Numbers 13,14.
 - b. Num 13:30. (Caleb) Able: to have power, having the capacity to prevail or succeed.
 - i. Joshua had to make decisions that went against the popular opinion.
 - ii. Joshua called upon the people to increase their faith in God's promises rather than look at the impossible circumstances.
 - iii. Spiritual Advancement requires faith, and unbelief will never see beyond the difficulties.
 - iv. Unbelief sees "walled cities and giants" rather than the presence and power of God.
 - v. Unbelief looks at obstacles; faith looks at God. Joshua and Caleb were willing to do the unpopular thing and call the people to positive faith.
 - vi. Unbelief caused them to believe a bad report from the 10 spies, and they rebelled against the word of the Lord to take the land and caused them to not be able to go into the promise land except Joshua and Caleb and Caleb's decedents.
 - c. When prayer is strategic it begins to hit the adversary directly and immobilizes the armies and destroys key strategic point.
 - i. Ephesians 6:12,18: Pray in the Spirit. Remember we are not in war against flesh and blood but against principalities, rulers, darkness in heavenly places.
 - ii. 2 Corinthians 10:4-5; James 4:7 and Mark 11:24
2. Positioning. Elijah and the Syrian army. People will need to be moved around to oversee specific areas. This is not a demotion but a promotion and will be necessary.
 - a. 2 Kings 6:8-14

3. Collaboration. Among HPC ministries and churches we are connected to
 - a. Psalm 133
 - b. Monthly Ministry Head Meetings and from that there will be Strategic Planning Meetings

4. Advancing in Faith. Fear Go, Faith Arise.
 - a. Caleb tried to get the Israelites to move forward on the land that God has promised them, but they refused due to fear. Because of this only Caleb and his dissidents and Joshua were able to go over and possess the land.
 - b. Faith never looks at the impossibilities but rather looks at the opportunities for God's Power to Manifest to produce His promises.
 - c. Many have never received the promises of God's fulfillment because of fear and disobedience.
 - i. Hebrews 11:1 (NKJV) Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. ⁶ But without faith *it is* impossible to please *Him*, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and *that* He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

5. Stewarding the vision, the people and the finances.
 - a. Hear my voice and do what I tell you to do even when it is not popular and goes against popular opinion. (Word to Pastor Randy).
 - b. Make sure the vision is moving in a direction to be able to begin implementing small steps that will enable a foundation being laid for larger portions of the vision.
 - c. Steward the people where they can be most productive and satisfying to their calling, time, family and HPC.
 - d. Finances: All excess moved into a high yield savings for maximum return.
